A Swindling Contest.

Mme. "La Comtesse de Choubroskoff," a lady who for some years past has figured in certain circles of Parisian society, has made her appearance at last before the Tenth Correctional Chamber, and has created no small sensation among the audience, not only by the remnants of beauty which still cling to her, but also by the coquettishness and elegance of her attire. Madame did not limit herself to the dignity of De Choubroskoff; she also gave herself out as the Countess d'Albani, the Grand Canoness of Bavaria, and used various other titles of equal authenticity. Her real name all the time being Marie Compt. According to the story she circulated about herself, the Countess de Choubroskoff was allied to all the great families of Russia, but had incurred the displeasure of the Czar when he married her organically in Moscow, the rite being afterwards legalized according to the Greek Church in Vienna. When her husband died he left her an estate worth £50,000 a year—an income which was always on the point of arriving in Paris, but never came. By the accounts of impending wealth she managed to impress upon many people, and it was these depredations from the paths of rectitude which necessitated her appearance before the magistrate. One of her victims was M. Alfred Stevens, a Belgian painter, from whom she purchased a canvas for £115, telling him that she intended to hang it in her salon at St. Petersburg, where it would be admired by all the Russian aristocracy. She paid a few pounds in advance, and gave him a "little bill" at two months for the rest. The picture was never sent to St. Petersburg, but was disposed of by the lady in Paris for nearly £100, and the bill was never met. Another victim was a diamond merchant, fascinated by her engaging manners and from whom she obtained £100 by false pretenses. Monsieur le President of the Court was very hard on the false Choubroskoff, about whose inability to produce her marriage certificate or that of her alleged husband's death, he made many jokes, as magistrates here often do. "The police have a very bad account of you in their records," said he. "You have already had a term for larceny. They represent you to be an audacious adventuress, and if you had been married to a grand seigneur Ruase it is very strange that among those you admitted to your intimate society was a convicted thief." MAKING NEWS AND NOTES.

The steamer Gen. Miles, Capt. L. A. Bailey, is due from Portland this morning on her way to Shoalwater Bay.

There has been a marked decrease in the amount of cargo of the Grand banks and the Gulf of St. Lawrence is now practically clear of ice.

The steamer Electric was yesterday turned over to her new owners, Messrs. Russell, Gunderson & Sorenson. They will continue to run her on the same route between this city and Skipanon and will undoubtedly give satisfaction to the public, as they are men experienced in the business.

The ship Ivy, Capt. A. L. Lowell, is nearly loaded, and will receive the balance of her cargo of lumber in a day or two. Then her crew will be shipped and the vessel will depart for Melbourne. She will carry about 900,000 feet of lumber. The ship is nearly ready, and was built near Seattle in 1877, and is 196 feet over all, beam 30 feet, draught 22 feet of water when loaded, carries 22 sails and a crew of 19 men. The ship is very neat and in perfect order.
