FATAL FLOODS IN FRANCE

Factories Destroyed, Bridges Swept Away, Railways Destroyed.

THE COUNTRY INUNDATED

Several Women Killed in the Town of Annonay, and at Last Accounts the River Was Still Rising.

Special to THE UNITED PRESS. PARIS, Sept. 24.—The town of Annonay, in the department of Arles, and the surrounding country has been flooded by an overflow from the Cance and Deaunier rivers, causing an immense amount of damage.

Last night K. J. Curtis went up on the steamer, and there is no doubt but what he went to interview William Reid, who is now claimed to be in readiness to settle the suit brought by Curtis as attorney against the Pacific Construction Company.

Resolved, That a message be wired to the representatives of the Pacific coast in the Senate and House, urging upon them the necessity of immediate action in the matter of obtaining an appropriation of a sufficient sum—say \$100,000—for the purpose of equipping a suitable vessel to proceed with the sounding for an ocean cable from the Pacific coast of the United States to New Zealand via Honolulu and Tutula.
