ELEGANT OCEAN STEAMER.

The United States Will Suffer From Such

Pacific ocean service of the Canadian Pacific railway, is the first of a fleet of three to trade between Vancouver, B. C., and China and Japan. The vessel is constructed to carry troops and speed of eighteen knots an hours e measured mile, and sixteen and one-half knots on a 500 mile sea trip. Engines will indicate ten thousand horse power. This vessel is 485 feet 51 feet breadth, 36 feet depth, 5,700 tons gross. The arrangements and fittings for passengers are of a luxurious kind.
