THE PUBLIC DOMAIN. Timber Lands Being Stripped and Ruined by Vandals. LAWS INADEQUATE TO PROTECT.

The annual report of Commissioner Groff, of the general land office, shows the number of agricultural patents issued during the fiscal year ended June 30, was 117,247, embracing 18,759,520 acres, as against 70,141 issued in 1889, with aggregate area of 11,220,500 acres.

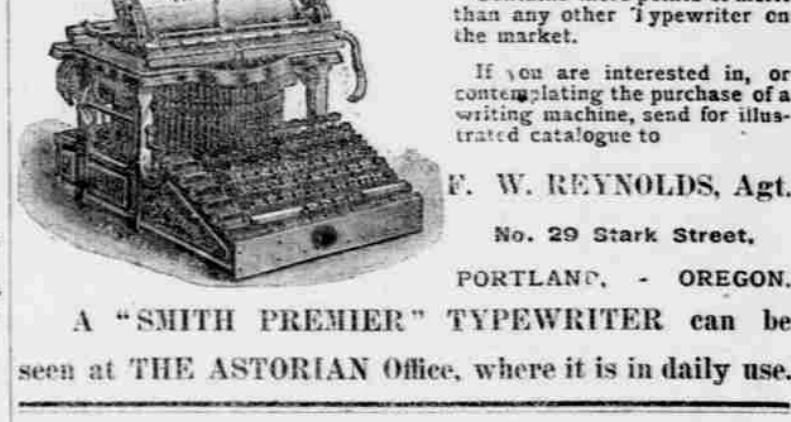
