Having stranded last year on the coast of Jutland, and been got off and repaired, she has been lying in Copenhagen Roads awaiting a buyer, and had just been purchased at an old iron and broken up. Albeit she had not the broad armor, only yesterday that unhappy sea elephant, the Great Eastern, and to-day this poor little hammer in more ways than one.

The sympathy and sentiment aroused in the two cases is hardly equal, and moreover, a torpedo boat must expect reverses. What is the exact portion of these craft which comes south, less out of naval manners it would be hard to say, but it cannot be very large. And if a well regulated class of torpedo boat that sails on the top of the water in a decent and reasonable fashion cannot help coming to grief, what can be expected of a submarine motor-boat which is neither fish, flesh, fowl, or good red herring." -Fall Mail Gazette.
