How to Choose a Turkey.

On Thanksgiving day every American family makes an effort to dine on turkey. The turkey, being a gift for which all Americans should be thank-There is being prepared for shipment from Pittsburg an important electric power plant, which is to be used in the gold region of the Telluride district, San Juan county, Colorado.

In the nine-mile area there are a law whisper to you not to rely implicitly on his judgment. Tastes differ, and upon this occasion you wish to suit In the nine-mile area there are a number of mines, producing a low grade ore, which have never been operated successfully, except in the case of the Gold King mine, on account of the cost of the fuel. At present the order is for 100 horse-power, and this will be used in the stamp mills, crushers, light plants and roadway of the Gold King mine. 


