Meeting of the City Council.

The regular bi-monthly meeting of the city council took place last night with Mayor M. C. Crosby in the chair, and present Councilmen Welch, Webber, O'Hara, Lewis, Thomson, Bergman, McGregor and Barker.

The roll was called and the minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

A petition for a liquor license for Megler & Wright was granted.

A communication from Dr. M. M. Walker in regard to his small-pox patient bill was placed on file.

A number of other communications were referred to appropriate committees.

The quarterly report of the water commission was referred to the city attorney.

Treasurer Wise and Auditor Osburn made their semi-annual reports.

An estimate from the city surveyor as to the probable cost of improving Elm street in Adair's Astoria, from the west side of Bonneville street to the east boundary of the John Adair D. L. C. was referred to the street committee.

An ordinance directing a notice to be published of the filing of the assessment roll number one, passed its second reading.

An ordinance appropriating \$500 for the benefit of Dr. M. M. Walker, passed its second reading.

A number of claims were ordered paid.

A resolution that the city surveyor be instructed to report his recommendation for grade on Ogden avenue from Elm to First street inclusive, was read and adopted.

A resolution that the city surveyor be instructed to recommend a table of grades for Second street in Adair's Astoria was read and adopted.

A resolution that the auditor and police judge be instructed to obtain from the county the amount of the property road tax to which the city is entitled, and pay the same into the treasury, was read and adopted.

A resolution that the city surveyor be instructed to prepare plans and estimate the cost of planing the John Day's county road from Jack's Sixth bridge to the next bridge above, was read and adopted.

A resolution that the proposition of Warren, Joplin, Stevens and Wilson, to settle for the work done on Court street in front of their property be accepted by their paying the costs of their suit in court, and the amount due the city under their proposition, was read and adopted.

On motion the council then adjourned.

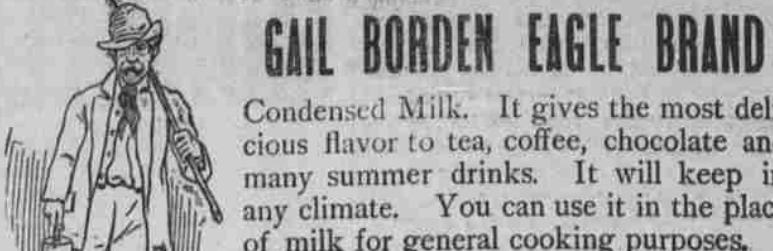
