New York, Dec. 14.—Rev. M. O'Byrne, a minister, committed suicide today by shooting himself in the head with a rifle. He was a graduate of Princeton and was ordained to the Presbyterian ministry six years ago. It is said he was mentally unbalanced from over study.

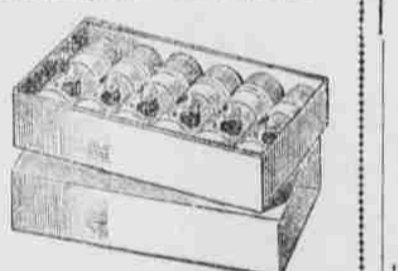
