A tag on one of them bears the inscription: "Coonage, chief of the Che-halts Tribe, alive and blind at the age of 100 years." The other reads, "Om-nault, chief, — 150 years old when he died." It does not state, however, when Chief Omnault turned up his toes, and nothing remains to indicate what tribe of Indians he presided over, but it is supposed that they were a tribe of the Cheshalls. Chief Coonage was born on the same day that good old Captain Gray salled into the broad Columbia, one hundred and three years ago last May.
