THIRTY-FIFTH STREET IMPROVEMENT NOTICE.

Notice is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of Astoria, Oregon, have determined to improve Thirty-fifth street from the north side of Franklin avenue to the south side of Duane street (exclusive of crossings) all in the city of Astoria, as laid out and recorded by John Adair, by grading to its full width and established grade, putting in new fire pipes, caps and strainers where necessary, and by planing with new and sound fir plank and by building sidewalks on both sides thereof.

All of the improvements to be made in accordance with the plans and specifications and ordinances in relation thereto.

The lands and premises upon which the special assessment shall be levied to defray the cost and expense of such improvement and the district embracing said lands and premises, be and the same are designated as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot Number 2, of Block Number 18, running thence north to the middle of the north line of Block Number 18, thence south through the middle of said Block 19, to the southeast corner of Lot 7, street, thence west to the southwest corner of Lot 6, in Block 18, thence north through the middle of said Block 18, to place of beginning, containing Lots 2, 4, 5 and 6, of Block 18, and Lots 1, 3, 7, and 8 of Block 19, all in Adair's Astoria.

Estimates of the expense of such improvements and plans and diagrams of such work or improvements, and of the locality to be improved, have been deposited by the City Surveyor with the Auditor and Police Judge for public examination and may be inspected at the office of such officer.

At the next regular meeting of the Common Council, after ten days from the final publication of this notice, to-wit:

On Wednesday, March 6th, 1896, at the hour of 7:30 p. m. at the City Hall, the said Council will receive and consider objections to such improvement being made, and if a remonstrance against such improvement, signed by persons owning more than one-half of the property in such district herein described and in which the special assessment is to be levied shall be filed with the Auditor and Police Judge, before the said time of meeting of the Common Council, no such improvement or work shall be ordered except by the consent of the Auditor and Police Judge, and if such remonstrance shall be signed by the persons owning three-fourths of all the property in such district and filed with the Auditor and Police Judge before the said time of meeting of the Common Council, no such improvement or work shall be ordered in any event.
