PROTECTION IN THE SOUTH.

The cry of protection which comes mamont dethronement of the free trade idea in that state. A Republican club of several hundred members, near all of whom have formerly been Deni occasts, has been organized at Atlanta for the purpose of supporting the pol ley of protection to home industries The president of the club is James D Collins, whom the Atlanta Constitutio. describes as a man of ability, forand popularity. Of the change o economic sentiment in the South, M Collins says:

"I am for protection. I know whn the people want, and I believe they will get it from the Republicans. W. have no force bill, no election bil now; the Democrats have adopted Reed's rules; they made a billion dollar congress, and they have satisfied me that they are no better than the Republicans. I don't see any use in hollering for the Democratic party b cause they are so badly apilt up tha no two of them agree on anything One thing I am satisfied of-Repub licans agree fully on taking care o all American industries, American la bor, American land, and American produots. They don't believe in building up big syndicates in Canada and dealing with foreign syndicates. It has been mainly prejudice that has kept people from joining the Republica party in this state. The prejudice ha died out since we have seen how the Democrats have acted."




