A bill now under consideration in the British parliament, with some show of passage, makes it a penal offense to disseminate by print or by word of mouth egainst a candidate for public office. The penalty prescribed is a fine of \$500 or loss of suffrage for five years. To be amenable to the law it is not necessary that the accused should originate the dander or that he believed it true. Having circulated the story the burden of proof is on him that he took pains to satisfy himself as to the truth of the allegation and found good reason for believing it. If there were such a law in country many editors would be minus either dollars or votes.

of silver precisely as a like increase of production has lowered the price of other commodities. It is a universal law

that price or value is measured by quan-tily. Under these conditions the rational and proper course would be a change of ratio, but this can only be effective as to these two metals by concert of action


