SHIPPING DAY BY DAY

Marine Matters, Here, There and Everywhere.

The steamer Empire, from San Francisco, is due today.

The Principality is due here with a cargo of coal from Newcastle.

At the Cape yesterday morning the wind had a velocity of 24 miles, falling to 12 at noon, and springing up to 25 at 4 o'clock.

The barkentine Monitor, lumber laden for San Francisco, is still lying in the stream. Her cargo consists of 248,000 feet. She cleared yesterday, and will probably sail today.

The steamer South Coast yesterday took on lumber at the Clatsop mills, but inquiry at the office of the company failed to disclose the amount. She will leave today for San Francisco.

On board the British ship Cawdor, on March 3, off the Paradoxes, James McDonald, seaman, a native of Toronto, aged 45 years, died from natural causes and was buried two hours later.

The British bark Lindbergh Abbey, which recently sailed from this port for Algoa Bay, South Africa, carried 3,000 sacks of Oregon flour, the value of which is \$45,000. All of which goes to show that Astoria may come in for some west coast trade.

The schooner reported as having arrived in Friday evening was the Letitia, from San Francisco. She docked at Packer's wharf, where she discharged her ballast, 20 tons, leaving up the river last evening in tow of the Pannic. She will load lumber for California.

The steamer Elmore, while turning from the wharf at Garibaldi on her way to this port, in some manner broke her shaft, and will be compelled to lay there until the steamer Harrison brings her a new one. The Harrison leaves for Tillamook this morning and will relieve the disabled steamer.

The steamer Transit, which was due on the Sound from Central America the latter part of February, will not arrive for two weeks. The discharging and loading of the vessel was much delayed on account of other vessels being ahead of her in the Central American ports where she stopped. Her principal cargo will consist of coffee, some of which is consigned to Tacoma merchants for home consumption.

The Northern Pacific steamship Victoria was due on the Sound yesterday. A very large amount of freight is awaiting the Victoria. Twelve cars of flour and machinery, which could not be taken upon the steamship Tacoma when she left last week, will be loaded upon her cargo. Other cargo has arrived for the Victoria as follows: One car load of tobacco from North Carolina, five car loads of cotton, amounting to 220 bales, and three tons of sundry merchandise.

Two ships are now on their way to Tacoma, both in charter by Halford, Guthrie & Co., to load lumber at the Tacoma mills for foreign ports. One of these is the British bark, Pass of Killis, Captain Adams, from San Diego. She has a tonnage of 1979 tons and is expected within a few days. The other vessel is the Earl of Dunmore, coming from Australia. She will load lumber at the St. Paul and Tacoma mill for the west coast of Africa. The Pass of Killis will take cargo at the Tacoma mill for orders.
