They are: The British bark Inverness-shire, from Liverpool; British bark Moselweyn, from Hamburg; the bark Little British bark Duxford, 632 tons, from Newcastle, N. S. W.; and the German ship Casaros, from Hamburg.

Second Mate Thomas Murray, of the British ship Brambletye, now loading wheat on the Sound for South Africa, is the sole survivor of one of the most noted disasters that ever occurred in Pacific waters. In 1885, while he was with the British ship Anglo-American, sailing along the Japanese coast, the vessel was overtaken by a furious gale, which soon grew into a typhoon, and, sweating the ship along at a terrific rate, carried her ashore on the island of Formosa.
