ROMAN CATHOLIC.

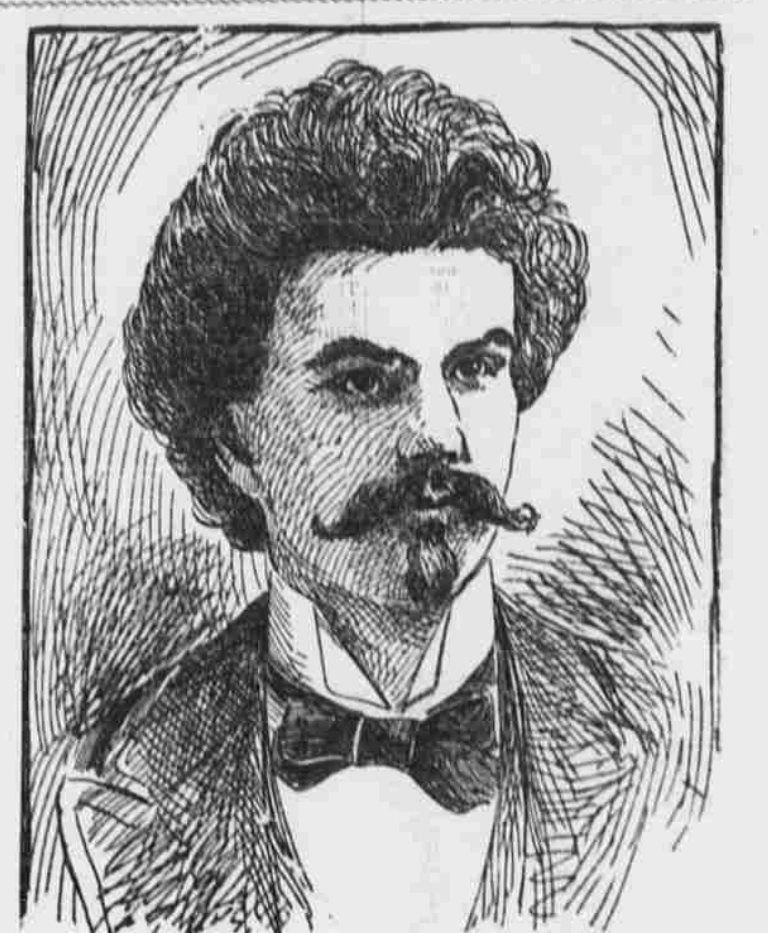
At Father Dielman's church the usual early service was held and at 10:30 the principal celebration of the day.
