WHY NOT TAKE CAMERON?

It has been intimated from various sections that if the Democratic national convention shall be controlled by the free silver forces, as now seems possible, it may nominate Cameron as its candidate for president, as such a nomination would assure his acceptance by the Populists and thus make a fusion between Democrats and Populists on the most vital issue of the contest.

At the Democratic national convention shall be controlled by the cheap money element, why should not Cameron be taken as its candidate? He is the strongest cheap money man in the country. He is a Democrat by birth and long cherished convictions, and he has absolutely severed his relations with the Republican party.

There is but one absorbing issue in the coming national contest, and that is sound or unsound money. On the question of the tariff it is taken for granted that if the Republicans succeed they will bring about a return to the protective policy, and there can be no issue in the minds of the people about that. So the money issue is the prominent issue before the people, and if the Democratic national convention shall degenerate into a free silver convulsion there will be eminent fitness in nominating Cameron for president.

A free silver national convention would be the last of the kind ever to be held by the Democratic party as a national organization, and if the Democracy shall choose to die without signs of resurrection by adopting the cheap money cause, they could do no better than to die in the embrace of Cameron.

marked down even temporarily are assured by the reflection that the floating mass of American shares and bonds in Europe has dwindled to such small proportions that even another "war scare" would probably not participate enough selling from that quarter to bring serious mischief.

For the present women will not be permitted to serve as lay delegates in the Methodist Episcopal general conference, but the vote has been so close that it is virtually a victory for them. as three-fourths are necessary to carry, the question was lost by the scant minority of 15. This shows that the tide has turned and sentiment is rapidly growing in favor of this movement to place women on the level with man.

The concession asked for had already been decided in the lower bodies by more than the constitutional three-fourths. These works wonders, it is a little more than a quarter of a century ago that laymen in the United States were admitted to the higher body, and their appointment is still by the pastor of a church to the lower conference, and by that in turn to the higher. Directly, the people have no voice in the matter. A few women were appointed lay delegates in 1883, the question of sex not being raised. The contention was that there was no constitutional prohibition, but the general conference interpreted the clause in another way, and the women were, perforce, obliged to wait for another opportunity. It has come and gone, but there is now so near the goal that there is scarcely any doubt but their patience will be rewarded when next the test is made.

Having won their first great battle in the fight for commercial supremacy and the advancement of home interests, the people at the mouth of the Columbia river can well congratulate themselves and for a few days look back upon the work accomplished. By unanimity of action and a hard, long pull all together, Astorians have opened the way for the development of the great resources of the city and county, and the opening up of a traffic whose magnitude has perhaps only been dreamed of by a few enthusiasts. A few of the results to be attained by the completion of the Astoria and Columbia River Railroad have been outlined in another column. The building of the railroad, however, is but the first step towards the accomplishment of the great ends desired and which can be attained. The hardest part of the work of building up a great city and establishing the avenues of commerce is yet to come. Only by persistent effort, the banishment of all petty jealousies, the sinking out of sight of personal ends and motives, and the burying of all factional strifes can anything like success become possible.

The greatest number must be the watchword of all interests of every description in city and county must be made to bend to the one great object. "You help me and I'll help you," is the principle that will win. When foreigners abroad in a city with but one idea—the Chicago idea of pushing itself—there are all circumstances they will soon want to plant their dollars here and lend a helping hand in the building of a port where millions are sure to be annually handled.

They talk as if no topic of less magnitude than "bimetallism," "the gold standard," "free trade" or "protective tariff" were ever broached in assembly chambers. In truth, questions relating to finance, commerce and industry are a fractional part of the time of our legislators, and high-sounding phrases should not be allowed to disguise the meaning, to the home, of even these subjects.

efforts to ameliorate these conditions are to the men thus engaged as ten to one. All legislation affecting childhood, all institutions for the criminal and poor, most interest women as directly as men. Who, if not women, are concerned in all legislation about food and sanitation? The vast amount of legislation on these subjects is a confession by the government that its final cause is the home, and it reveals the extent to which legislation tends itself to securing public conditions which will best conserve the interests of private life.

As one further result of this aspect of legislation, the function of women in the state is becoming apparent. The lesson of centuries has not been lost upon women. They have been taught that they are the guardians of home interests. If this be true, it is not incidental to certain states where the object is to serve and conserve the home that the guardians of the home are the proper critics, judges and directors of the state, in so far as the state deals with domestic questions? Women today are crippled in the performance of purely domestic duties by their exclusion from direct participation in legislation, crippled exactly as miners, weavers, machinists, farmers, lumbermen and merchants of the male sex would be were these class disfranchised.
