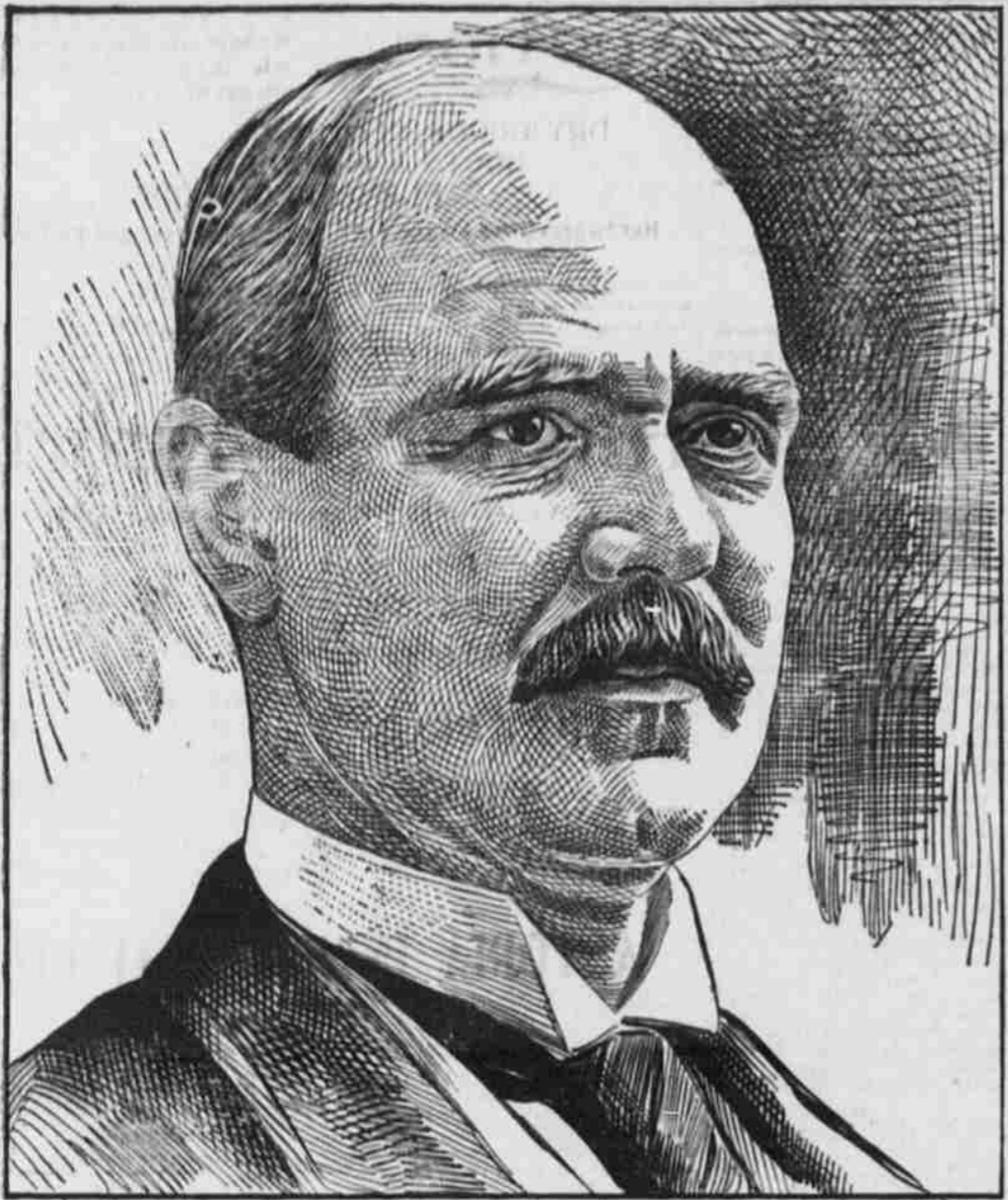


NEAR THE WHITE HOUSE.

Article V.—It will be the duty of the officers of the United States who may be in localities where sea otter are taken, and who have knowledge of any such offense having been committed, to take all proper measures to enforce the penalties of the law.
