We are unalterably opposed to any scheme that will give to this country a depreciated or debased currency.

A year ago, in Thomaston, Ga., Major McKinley, when offered the delegates of three Southern states if he would decline for free silver, said, in the presence of the editor of this journal: 'If the Republican platform declares for free coinage, I will not be a candidate. I would not run on a free silver platform.'

'I believe the Republican party at St. Louis should be governed by a conservative sentiment respecting the tariff, but it cannot be too pronounced on the money question. I am in favor of an explicit and unequivocal declaration in favor of maintaining the gold standard; for the money question and not the tariff, will be the issue of the campaign this year.'

'The agricultural, manufacturing, mercantile and wage-earning interests of the United States, have now an opportunity to put this country beyond the cavil of doubt on a sound, safe and permanent gold basis. The party which fails to see that this is the only true issue, and to take its stand on a gold platform, will fight a losing battle in the coming campaign.'

'After struggling for more than a quarter of a century, through labor organizations and otherwise, to secure a rate of wages which would make the proceeds of a day's work equal to the cost of a day's subsistence for the workingman and his family, you are asked by the advocates of free coinage to join them in destroying one-half of the purchasing power of the money in which you are paid, and impose upon yourselves the task of doubling the nominal amount of your wages hereafter; that is, to struggle for another quarter of a century, or perhaps longer, to raise your wages in a depreciated currency to a point which will enable you to purchase with them as much of the necessities of life as you can purchase now; and if, after years of contention, privation and industrial disorder, you should at last succeed in so adjusting wages that they would procure at the higher prices of commodities just what they will procure now at the existing prices, what would you have gained by the change from the old to the new conditions? Money received for wages, like money received on every other account, is valuable only to the extent that it can be exchanged for other commodities, and it is scarcely necessary to suggest that a dollar worth 50 cents will not purchase as much in the market as a dollar worth 100 cents. To call a dime a dollar would add nothing whatever to its intrinsic value or purchasing power; it would still buy only a dime's worth of goods.'

SOUND MONEY HAS WON AT ST. LOUIS.

All the states and territories, except Alaska, to be represented at St. Louis in the national Republican convention have adopted their platforms, and from these a perfectly trustworthy forecast may be made of the financial plank to be framed by that body.

Thirty-three states and territories, representing a total of 760 delegates, have pronounced unqualifiedly for the gold standard and against the free and unlimited coinage of silver at any ratio.

Nine states and territories, representing a total of eighty-four votes in the convention, have adopted a free silver platform.

Eight, including Alabama, Florida, Kansas, Louisiana, West Virginia, New Mexico, Oklahoma and the Indian territory, constituting a total of ninety-two votes, are doubtful.

Adding ninety-two to the eighty-four, the convention will stand for the gold standard and against the free coinage of silver at any ratio, 760 to 176.

The question, therefore, of the money platform of the national Republican convention is settled conclusively and finally. From that body will come forth to the country the first inspiring note giving an impulse of a new life and warrant for confident energy to the long disheartened industrial powers of the nation, to its labor and its capital, its genius and its enterprise.

On that platform William McKinley will be nominated for president of the United States. On that platform he will be elected with him a congressional majority competent to take up the questions of national finance and national revenue. Upon that platform legislatures will be chosen which in two years will wrest the

senate of the United States from free silver wreckers and give to a Republican house and a Republican president the cooperation necessary to bring back the country to prosperity long denied by sectional selfishness, economic ignorance and partisan bigotry.

Seven hundred and forty to 176 ends the fight for honest money and assures the future of the nation.

A favorable report has been ordered by the house committee on interstate and foreign commerce on the Mabon Nicaragua canal bill, as amended by the subcommittee. As reported, the bill provides that the canal company shall have a capital stock of \$100,000,000, the shares to be non-assessable, and the number not to be increased except with the consent of congress. It provides that if the canal company shall, within nine months after the passage of the act, show that all the shares heretofore issued, except those issued to Nicaragua and Costa Rica, have been called in and canceled, the secretary of the treasury shall subscribe in behalf of the United States 700,000 shares (\$70,000,000) to the capital stock of the company in return for the guarantee of the bonds to be issued by the company. Ten thousand shares of stock shall also be issued to the holders of the stock surrendered. The directorate is to consist of eleven members, one each to be appointed by Nicaragua and Costa Rica, one by the canal company and eight by the president, with the advice and consent of the senate.

Altegold says: 'Practically the gold dollar is a 26-cent dollar.' Then every greenback must be a 26-cent dollar, because redeemable in gold. Then every silver dollar in circulation now must be a 26-cent one, because it is as good as a gold dollar. So if every dollar is worth twice its nominal value the country must have twice as much money as it thought it had. According to the treasury department the total circulation is \$1,725,000,000. But if he is correct, and that \$1,725,000,000 is double-value money, as he alleges, then the country has \$2,200,000,000 of money. And yet Altegold thinks that is not enough, and at the same time champions a plan to decrease it. For he claims free coinage would cut down the value of the gold dollar—that is, of every United States dollar—just one-half. Then, according to him, the utility or purchasing power of the money now in circulation would shrink one-half. Then he would have the contraction he decries. Altegold is not a very logical demagogue.
