Movements of Vessels at Home and Elsewhere.

The steamer Signal arrived down from Portland yesterday.

The steamer Harrison arrived in from Tillamook yesterday morning.

The U. S. S. Philadelphia arrived in at 5 o'clock yesterday morning and left up at 5 for Portland.

The barkentine Portland arrived down yesterday from Portland, lumber laden for Southern coast points.

The Oriental steamer Mount Lebanon, which has been due for several days, is confidently expected this morning.

The steamer State arrived down from Portland at an early hour yesterday and left out for San Francisco with a large freight and passenger list.

Another Austrian war vessel will visit San Francisco. She is the training brig Artemida and is coming from China via Honolulu. The vessel only carries two guns, and is used solely for training sailors for the navy.

San Francisco Call: Now that a pilot boat has appeared at the entrance to the straits Puget Sound pilots are discussing the advisability of establishing a pilot station at Cape Flattery. Many times when vessels approach the Cape, it is claimed, they are compelled to stand off because no tugs are in sight, while with a pilot aboard they could run inside safely and find a good harbor while waiting for a tug.
