says a just issued departmental notice, "a fog bell established by the Rogers, Druggist. government of Canada will be operated at the light station on Potlock point, Prevest Island, Trincomalle channel, off the east coast of Vancouver Island, by designing monograms. The bell is suspended in a small wooden tower painted white, (removed from Active Pass light station) docated on a low point 900 feet southeast from the lighthouse. The bell will be struck by a hammer operated by machinery, and regulated to give one stroke every fifeen seconds.

There are some interesting facts about the British mercantile marine and the English shipbuilding trade in Lloyd's statistical tables for 1895. It aptonnage during the year was 783,399 tons gross, and of sailing tonnage 64,383 tons gross, or in all 747,782 tons gross. The tonnage sold to foreigners exceeded by 43 per cent the exceptionally high figure of 1894. As in 1894, Japan was the largest purchaser, that country having acquired from the United Kingdom 25 steamers of 68,083 tons. Among other principal nurchasets may be men tioned Norway, 63.117 tons; Italy, 42,668 tons; France, 36,060 tons; Germany, 21,271 tons; and Spain, 23,368 tons.
