MATTERS MARINE

Movements of Vessels at Home and Elsewhere.

The Conica was towed up river yesterday afternoon.

The steamer Harrison arrived in from the Sound yesterday afternoon with a cargo of coal.

The steamer Empire arrived down from Portland yesterday, bound for San Francisco and coast points.

The British bark Harland arrived down stream from Portland yesterday afternoon. She had on board 39,842 sacks of wheat, and lighted 2226 sacks. She will sail today for Falmonth for orders. Captain Johnston is her master. Two of the crew who were placed in the hospital here upon her arrival in port, are still too sick to go with their vessel, and will be left behind.

While the barkentine Monitor was being towed from Tacoma to sea Wednesday by the tug Elk, a carrier pigeon alighted in the rigging at dusk and was caught after dark by the sailors. The bird was evidently weary from a long flight. On its left foot was a tin tag bearing the following indented brand: "F. G. Z. 246 '95." Captain Olsen, of the Elk, took the bird and now has it in his possession. The Elk is a Tacoma boat—Ledger.

The handsome steamer Monmouthshire, which until recently was a "tramp," and is now chartered in the O. R. and N. Oriental line, arrived in the harbor yesterday noon, fourteen days from Yokohama. She is the handsomest and largest vessel of the fleet, and made an exceptionally fast run. Her cargo is a general one, consisting of tea, silks, curios, etc., consigned in bond to the through railway line for various merchants at Philadelphia, New York, Canton, Ohio, Boston, and Portland, Or., and Chicago. She left up river about 3 p. m.

The following extract from a private letter received from Captain Penfield, who went to the Yukon to superintend the putting together of a steamer shows that money is not tight on the Yukon river, and that steamboatmen up there are getting good wages: "There are thirteen boats plying on the Yukon river. The largest of these is the P. B. Geare, which is 175 feet long, 22 feet beam, and 700 tons burden. She has 15 deck hands, two mates and three Indian pilots. One pilot takes the steamer to the mouth of the river, a distance of 75 miles; another takes it to the White Horse rapids, and the third from there to the head of navigation, 1800 miles altogether. She carries most of the freight in her hold, with the cordwood on deck. Three trips are made each season. The other steamers are the Arctic, Alice and J. J. Healy. Wood is \$5 per cord, and not the best at that. Pilots' wages are \$125 per month, during 7 1/2 months' run. Deckhands are getting \$45 and found. Firemen receive \$75 per month for 7 1/2 months of the year. Everybody has money here. Last night two men of the Portland's crew pulled two men from the steamer to the barkentine C. C. Funke, about a mile, and got \$3 for the job."—San Francisco Commercial News.
