MATTERS MARINE

The steamer Columbia will sail this morning for San Francisco. The British ship Melanoe arrived in yesterday afternoon in ballast from Port Adelaide.

The steamer Arcata left out yesterday morning with a cargo for San Francisco and coast ports.

The steamer Empire sailed yesterday afternoon with a cargo of 200,000 feet of lumber and 150 cords of stove wood for San Francisco.

The Mariposa brought one of the most valuable cargoes that ever reached San Francisco into port yesterday. Among it was 35 boxes of English sovereigns, valued at \$125,000.

"I hold the disturbance of the measure of value, the means of payment and exchange or any derangement of the currency to be one of the most unpardonable of political faults. He who tampers with the currency robs labor of its bread. He panders, indeed, to greedy capital, which is keen-sighted, and may shift for itself; but he beggars labor, which is honest, unsuspecting, and too busy with the present to calculate for the future."

"The prosperity of the working classes lives, moves, and has its being in reasonable wages, and a steady medium of payment. All sudden changes destroy it. Honest industry never comes in for any part of the spoils in that scramble which takes place when the currency of a country is disordered. Did violent fluctuations ever do good to him who depends on daily labor for his daily bread? Certainly never. All these things may gratify greediness for sudden gain, but they can bring nothing but injury and distress to the homes of patient industry and honest labor. Who are they who profit by such a state of things? They are not the many, but the few. They are speculators, brokers, dealers in money, and lenders of money at exorbitant interest. Small capitalists are crushed, their means dispersed in various parts of the country, and such a miserable "pottery having destroyed exchanges, they have no longer either money or credit. All classes of labor partake, and must partake, in the same calamity."—Daniel Webster.

In the light of the present political situation in this country, the following extract from the great essay of Macaulay, written on the future of the American commonwealth, and published in the year 1856, is certainly one of the most astounding prophecies ever made in the history of the world:

"The day may come in the United States when a multitude of the people, oppressed by hard times, will be called upon to choose rulers. On one side will stand a statesman preaching patience, respect for vested rights, and strict observance of the public faith. On the other side will stand a demagogue, ranting about the tyranny of usurers and capitalists. Let us hope that if such a season of adversity ever comes, the American nation will not act like people who would in a year of scarcity devour all the seed corn, and thus make the next year a year, not of scarcity, but of absolute famine."

BYRAN ANTIDOTE.

1. That omission of the silver dollar from free and unlimited coinage in 1873 destroyed half our money.

2. That the act of 1873 "destroyed silver as money."

3. That the act of 1873 was a "gold conspiracy against silver."

4. That legislation can keep up the price of silver.

5. That because silver cannot be kept at par with gold, in a "poor" country like Mexico, it must not be presumed the United States cannot keep the metals at par.

6. That gold and silver with free coinage at 16 to 1 is the "money of the constitution."

7. That free coinage of silver at 16 to 1 of gold is the money of Jefferson, Hamilton and Jackson.

8. Bryan garbles Blaine and quotes Carlisle before the great era of silver production set in.

9. That dropping the silver dollar from the coinage of 1873 cut down prices and wages.

10. That while free coinage of silver will advance prices of commodities, it will also advance wages.

11. The same report shows that between 1850 and 1885, when gold went to a premium, as it will under free coinage of silver, the average price of all articles in this country advanced 116 per cent and the average increase in wages was 43 per cent, although during that time there were withdrawn from the labor market 2,800,000 men, making a scarcity of labor. There will be no withdrawal now. Wages, therefore, cannot rise, because the supply will be in excess of the demand.
