SPITTING ON THE SIDEWALKS. Astoria, Nov. 6, 1896. To the Editor:- Thirteen years have passed since a peculiar microbe was proven to be the cause of consumption, and that microbe is nearly always present in the spit of those who have that disease.

Another important fact is crowding in upon us too; and that is that consumption is hardly ever hereditary, but is caused usually somehow by the consumption microbes passing from one individual to the lungs of another.
