The steamer Empire arrived yesterday from San Francisco, leaving up in the afternoon.

The British bark Criffle and the ship Machrihanish left up the river Sunday to load wheat.

The British bark Glenluie sailed yesterday for Queenstown or Palmyra, with 103,662 bushels of wheat, valued at \$73,500.

The lighthouse tender Columbine arrived yesterday from Puget sound and Destruction Island, where she had delivered supplies.

The steamship Columbia arrived yesterday from San Francisco and, after discharging freight for Astoria merchants, left up the river.

The G. W. Wolf yesterday finished discharging her second barge load of cement and will discharge the balance of her cargo onto the O. R. and N. dock.

The steamship State of California sailed Sunday for San Francisco, 24 hours behind time, as a result of the storm. She had large freight and passenger lists.

The British ship Chelmsford, Captain Thompson, sailed yesterday for the United Kingdom, after having been weather bound for over a week. She carries 142,133 bushels of wheat, valued at \$102,500—one of the most valuable grain cargoes which has ever been shipped from this port.

The severe storm of the past week has used the Glenmorag and Zita very well. The former pounded considerably, but was not damaged to any great extent, and it is said the Glenmorag was driven 100 yards further up on the beach.

The Oceanic Steamship Company's Monowai sailed for Australia Thursday afternoon. The American passengers have not been forgotten, and Thanksgiving day will be duly celebrated.

Within thirty-six hours ending last night 25 deep water vessels entered this port, the largest number in a long time. Two of these were regular traders from the Hawaiian Islands.
