Horizontal dealing with the tariff question will not be satisfactory to the American people. The St. Louis platform pledges the administration to the enactment of a tariff law that shall be adapted to present industrial conditions. A 15 per cent horizontal ingrease on all the schedules but two, which is a feature of the bill, does not conform to these conditions. The duties on the various articles of import must be governed by conditions affecting the particular industries which they repre

Another feature which the permanent tariff law of 1897 must possess is the substitution of specific for ad valorem rates of duty. The ad valorem method of levying imposts is repugnant to advanced ideas of tariff legislation. It opens the door for fraud and misrepre sentation and is a fruitful source of litigation. The Dingley bill could not answer the requirements of a perfect tariff law which was intended for any degree of permanency for the reason that it does not provide for this very desirable change in the imposition of duties.


