

DUTES OF ELECTORS.

How the Vote is Counted and Trans mitted to the Capitol.

Just how or where or when the electoral vote is cast, seems to be something of a mystery to many voters who are vell-informed on all other subjects. the same day, in accordance with a der, the whistle having been replaced. provision of the United States which

The electors for each state shall meet and give their votes upon the first Wednesday in December, in the year in which they are appointed, at such place in each state as the legislature of each state may direct."

In Oregon, and in most of the other states, there is special legislation providing that the votes shall be cast at the state capitol.

for any contingency that might arise. Each state may, by law, provide for the of any vacancies which may occur in its college of electors, when such diege meets to give its electoral vote. In Oregon, should such a vacancy ocur, the electoral college has power to elect persons to fill such vacancies, and should it happen that two persons receive the same number of votes, the governor makes the choice by lot. It will be seen, therefore, that no adverse state administration could

affect the eletcoral vote. After the voes are formally cast, three certificates are made, in which the votes for president and vice-president

are given in senarate lists. The college then chooses a person, not ecessarily a member of its body, to personally take one certificate to Washington. This he must deliver to the president of the senate before the first week in January. In the event of that officer not being in Washington when the messenger arrives, the accretary of state is empowered to take charge of

the certificate. The second certificate must be sent to the president of the senate by mail, so as to reach Washington before the first week in January.

The third certificate is delivered to the federal judge of the district in which the electoral colleg meets, On the second Wednesday of February, congress is in session and the eletoral vote is formally canvassed.

Should it happen that neither of the first two certificates reach Washington by the second Wednesday in February. the secretary of state at once sends a special messenger to the federal judge who is in possession of the third certificate, and that is then taken to Wash-

Each messenger is paid mileage upon urrender of the certificate, to the amount of twenty-five cents for each mile he has travelled by the most dinot usually exceed six cents per mile for the round trip, he is a few dollars to the good. Messengers from the remote states are thus quite well paid for their time. The man who will carry the certificate for Oregon will be ahead about \$600 on the trip.
