The steamer State of California arrived down at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon and shortly afterward sailed for San Francisco. She left Portland on time, but upon arrival at the mouth of the Willamette the fog was so thick that it was found unsafe to proceed further, and the big steamer anchored there for the night.

Captain Crowter of the British ship Lochester Castle, now in San Francisco harbor, has in his cabin a miniature gloop yacht, built by his own hands, which he is willing to match against any craft of its class on the Pacific coast.

Much speculation has been caused among Americans interested in Puget Sound shipping as to the meaning of the word "Maru," which forms a part of the name of all Japanese vessels visiting the Sound.

One of the floats which Captain Petrie of the British steamer Lintithgow, set afloat before he abandoned his vessel in mid-Pacific several months ago, was picked up many weeks later by the barkentine Tam o'Shanter.

This is the first of Captain Petrie's floats that have been heard from, but it is expected that others will be reported soon.—San Francisco Chronicle.
