Labor agitators, those who make a living for themselves by attempting to make others discontented, constantly assert that the number of employed is decreasing and that wages are growing lower. The statistics of the United States census office from 1870 to 1890 disprove these assertions, showing a constant increase both in the number of persons employed and their average yearly earnings. To this the agitator during the last campaign replied that. although 1890 was a prosperous year, since then there has been a decrease. and the condition of the workingman is not as good as it was. Conclusive evidence that wages have increased and more men are employed is furnished by the report of the Massachusetts bureau of labor statistics, which has just been ssued. This is the best of the state labor bureaus, and its statistics are never disputed by statisticians, not even by those who criticise the federal census. The employes of the Massacreased. 




