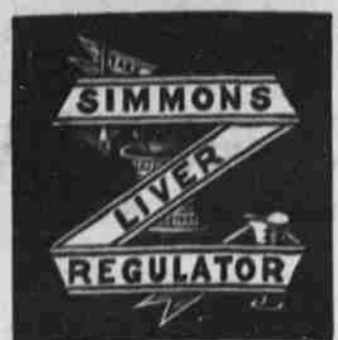

MARINE NEWS.

The steamer State of California will sail at 4 o'clock this morning for San Francisco.

The steamer Harvest Queen will arrive down this morning and take the up cargo of the Blanchard to Portland.

The schooner Sacramento arrived yesterday from San Francisco in ballast and was towed up the river by the steamer Fanny to Portland, where she will load lumber.

The Alice Blanchard cleared yesterday for San Francisco with a cargo of 280 tons of shooks, 26,000 feet of lumber and 1,200 bundles of shooks. She will sail this morning.

The following statement shows the number of emigrants who left Liverpool for places out of Europe during the month ended 28th February, 1897: United States, 2,360; British North America, 790; Australasia, 160; other places, 239; total, 3,475—Liverpool Journal of Commerce.

The schooner Equator is being rebuilt with a steam propeller and will hereafter be known as the steamer Equator. She was originally built by Matthew Turner in 1888 for Joseph Hume. She is now owned by the Alaska Packers' Association, and is being fitted for the Alaska trade. The necessary machinery is being put in and the rebuilding is being done by the Fulton Engineering and Shipbuilding Company—Chronicle.

A very ingenious and simple contrivance is used to bring to the surface samples of sea water taken from great depths, and unmixed with water from the other depths which it has passed through in reaching it. It consists of a cylinder with a valve opening upward at each end, the two valves being connected with a shaft. These valves open as the cylinder goes down, allowing the water to flow through it. On the top of the cylinder is a small propeller attached to a threaded shaft, and when the cylinder is drawn up this propeller revolves, screwing down the shaft, which in turn screws down onto the valves, sealing them hermetically, with the sample of water which was inside the cylinder when the upward motion began. Some of the most interesting problems of deep sea investigation have been worked out from the water taken in this way.
