

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF COMMERCIAL STREET.

Notice is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of Astoria, Clatsop county, Oregon, has decided and determined to extend Commercial street, in the City of Astoria, the beginning, terminus and intermediate points, and the land to be condemned being hereinafter described and set forth, and as more fully appears by the report, maps, plans and surveys of said proposed extension of Commercial street, now on file in the office of the Auditor and Police Judge, and endorsed and described in Ordinance No. 2231, entitled "An ordinance confirming the report, plan of survey, of the proposed extension of Commercial street," approved March 22, 1897, and that such of said persons possess the qualifications of Jurors of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Clatsop, in that they and each of them are white male citizens of the United States and of the State of Oregon, over the age of 21 years, and are and have been residents and legal voters of Astoria, Clatsop county, Oregon, and of the wards in which they now reside, for more than one year last past, and each of their names are on the tax roll of said Clatsop county, and that each of them are subject to jury duty, and that each and all of said above named persons, after investigation made, are entitled and qualified to act as viewers as required by the charter of the City of Astoria, and possessing all the qualifications necessary therefor as fully and satisfactorily appears to the Common Council, after the investigation made aforesaid, and each of said named persons having by a written statement, filed in the office of the Auditor and Police Judge, having declared that they possess the necessary qualifications to act as viewers aforesaid, the said J. H. Mansell, C. W. Stone and T. O. Trullinger be and they are hereby appointed viewers to view the proposed extension of Commercial street in the City of Astoria, as described in his said report, which said report was adopted by the Common Council of the City of Astoria in said Ordinance No. 2231, and are hereby authorized and empowered to make the assessment of benefits and damages in opening and condemning said Commercial street, as required by the charter of the City of Astoria, that said viewers hereby appointed are hereby required and instructed to meet at the office of the Auditor and Police Judge in the City Hall of said City of Astoria on the 12th day of April, 1897, at the hour of 10 o'clock in the forenoon of said day, and then and there to qualify as such viewers as required by the charter of the City of Astoria.

STREET IMPROVEMENT NOTICE.

Notice is hereby given that the common council propose to improve 23d street from Franklin avenue to Harrison avenue, Harrison avenue from 23d street to 25th street, 25th street from Harrison avenue to Irving avenue, in that portion of the city of Astoria known as Adair's Astoria. Said improvement to consist in grading said streets to a width of 30 feet through the center thereof to their established grades, and by planing the same to a width of 14 feet through the center thereof with new and sound fir planks 2x12 inches, laid one inch apart, in accordance with the plans and specifications and ordinances in relation thereto.

The lands and premises upon which the special assessment shall be levied to defray the costs of said improvement and the district embracing said improvement and lands and premises to be assessed therefor are hereby designated as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the northwest corner of lot 2 in block 25, in Adair's part of Upper Astoria, which point is in the main line between the Adair D. L. C. and the Shively D. L. Estimates of the expense of such improvement and planing and specifications of the locality to be improved will be on file in the office of the Auditor and Police Judge for public examination. That at the next regular meeting of the common council, after 10 days from the expiration of the notice of such improvement, to-wit: on Friday, May 7, 1897, the said common council will consider any objections to such improvement being made; and if a remonstrance, signed by one-half of the property-owners in the above-described district, be filed against such improvement in the office of the Auditor and Police Judge before said 7th day of May, 1897, no such work or improvement will be made except by the concurrence of two-thirds of all the members of the common council elect. And unless such remonstrance be filed, the common council will order said improvement to be made.
