The China steamer Chinglong is expected to arrive in a few days.

The Amarspora will start down the river from Portland in a few days.

The British steamer Reliance, Captain Robinson, arrived down from Portland yesterday.

The steamer Harrison arrived in from the Sound yesterday with a cargo of coal.

Gradually, says the American Economist, we excluded foreign ships from our coastwise trade by prohibitive tonnage dues, and finally, in 1817, we absolutely prohibited, by law, foreign vessels from engaging in any trade between American ports. The consequence of this more than century-old prohibitive protection of our domestic shipping is that we have the largest domestic water borne commerce in the world, and our freight charges for inland water borne transportation are lower than anywhere else in the world and the magnitude of our shipping is only equaled by its utility, its safety and its beauty. Why not do as well by our foreign shipping?

NOTICE TO MARINERS. Washington Sound, Washington.

Notice is hereby given that on April 3 the following named buoys were established in Washington Sound.

This notice affects the list of buoys, buoys and day marks, Pacific coast, 1895.

Bellingham Bay, page 65. Bellingham Bay rocks buoy, a second-class can with red and black horizontal stripes, is moored in 22 feet of water, and marks the southern side of the submerged rocks between Eliza Island and Point Francis.

Eliza Island, north point, southeast three-fourths east; Chuchanut Island, center, northeast by east three-fourths east; Point Francis, northwest five-eighths west. When the buoy bears between west southwest (by 80) and southwest it should be given a berth of 700 yards.

Hale Passage, page 66. Point Francois buoy, No. 9, a first-class spar, red, is moored in 24 feet of water, and mark the edge of the foul ground off Point Francois.

Eliza Island, north point, southeast three-fourths east; Point Francis, northwest three-eighths west.

Shannon Point buoy, No. 2, red, a second-class spar, is moored in 24 feet of water, and marks the rocks off Shannon Point.

Shannon Point, southwest one-eighth south; Cypress Island, southwest point, northwest by west three-fourths west; Cypress Island, southwest point, north northwest one-eighth west.

Rosario Strait, page 66. Lawson reef bell buoy, red and black horizontal stripes, is moored in 36 feet of water, and marks a shoal of the eastern end of Lawson reef.

Southwest Island, west by south; Smith Island Lighthouse, south southwest one-eighth west; Deception Island, northeast five-eighths east.

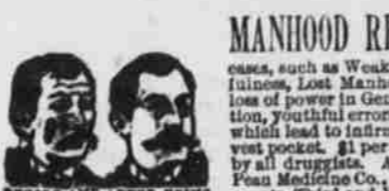
