

Truilinger be and they are hereby appointed viewers to view the proposed extension of Commercial street in the City of Astoria, as desorthed by the Surveyor and embodied in his said report, which said report was adopted by the Common Council of the City of Astoria in said Ordinance No. 2231, and are hereby authorized and empowered to make the assegment of benefits and damages in opening and condemning of said Commercial street, as required by the cnarviewers herein appointed are hereby required and instructed to meet at the office of the Auditor and Police Judge in the City Hall of said city of Astoria on the 30th day of April, 1897, at the hour of 10 o'clock in the foresoon of said day, and then and there to qualify as such viewers as required by the charter of the City of Astoria.

That the boundaries, beginning, terminus, intermediate points and description of the property to be entered upon and condemned for the proposed extension of said Commercial street are described as follows to wit:
