

WE NEED A FEW LIKE HIM.

How Great Britain Defends Her Subjects in Foreign Lands.

New Orleans, May 22.-General J. Drummond, a British subject, who led the revolution at Port Cortez, Honduras, and who was captured and conveyed to San Pedro, was released on the eve of his execution upon the demand of the commander of the English war ship Intrepid. The news comes by the steamer Honduras, which has just arrived here. The intrepid dropped into Port Cortex a week ago last Wednesday and her commander at once requested to know of the Honduras offidals if there were any foreigners in jail who had been arrested for connection with the revolution.
