It is evident to the most casual observer that the railroad was prefected and is being built as a simple straight business proposition. Seventy - five pound English steel rails, the heaviest cedar piling, steel bridges, stone ballast and modern equipment are not usually purchased and put into a railroad plant on mere speculation. The road is being built to handle the heaviest traffic the teas and silks of the Orient for distribution in the East; the wheat flour and the lumber, fish and Jairy products of export to the countries of the Old World; th elumber, fish and dairy products of Clatsop county to the interior. Before the roud can secure this traffic there must be the means here for producing traffic and for loading and unloading ships. There must be saw mills, flour mills, as well as shipyards, dry docks and elevators. Last and not least, but rather above all, connections and artangements must be made with transcon tinental roads for through service and through rates. These are the practical things that doman't the immediate and serious attention of every business man in the city. The mere building of the road, with all its heavy rails and substanrfal equipment, will not produce these indispensible accessories. 




