The members of the Fishermen's Union held a large meeting yesterday afternoon at Erikson's hall. After some discussion, a committee of five was appointed to confer with the board of directors of the Union Co-operative Fishermen's cannery at 2 o'clock today for the purpose of discussing the situation and arriving at some solution of the question of providing for all of the men.

The men realize that under present conditions four cents is too high for fish, but the great difficulty is how to adjust matters so that we won't starve. The trouble is, there is too much high-priced gear of all kinds on the river and too many men in the business, to come out losers. Only those who take the greatest risks get many fish.

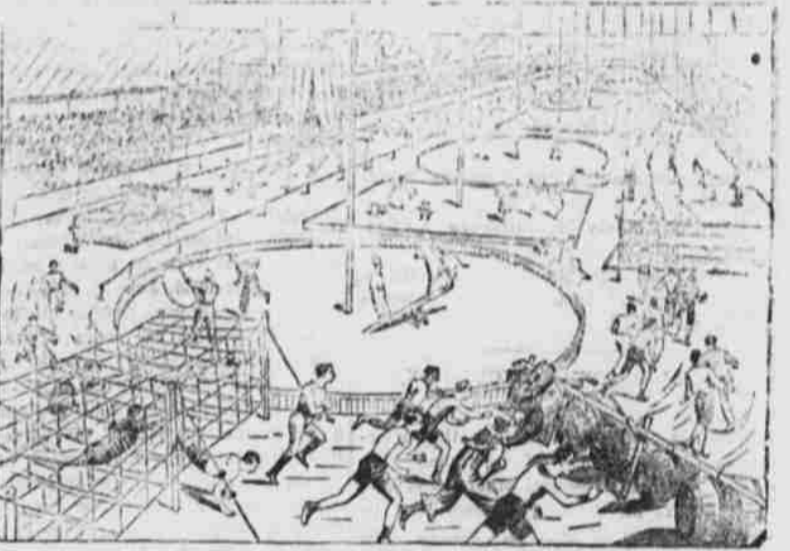
