





In other words, it took the exported surplus of our bread. stuffs production to furnish us with sugar. One hundred million a year sent abroad for something we ought to produce at home! Is there any stronger incentive to the development of the beet sugar industry in the United States? The beginnings of a new industry are always slow. Especially is this the case where it demands large investments of capital in manufacturing plants. The ruising weight. of the beets does not require much risk on the part of the farmers. But the beets are valueless to them, except for food and forage, unless there is a sugar factory within easy reach, where the beets can be sold.
