Toledo Blade. A year ago, Mr. William J. Bryan, of Nebraska, made a stupping tour of the United States in an unsuccessful chase after the presidency.

One of his pet arguments was that "the price of wheat and the price of silver go hand in hand." By a coincidence, the price of a bushel of wheat at that time, and the value of the bullion in the silver dollar, were within two cents of each other.

But the condition of the silver and the wheat markets on the same day this year disproves the Bryan assertion completely.

Here are their prices on July 23, 1897: Value of bullion in silver dollar... \$2.00 Wheat per bushel... .45

There could be no more crushing refutation of Bryan's assertion of last year than the price of silver and the price of wheat go hand in hand—that when silver goes up wheat advances, and when silver goes down wheat falls.

No wonder Bryan is silent just now. His main argument of last year is conclusively disproved. And with it falls the interest of the farmers in the silver folly is gone.
