

CHINESE EXCLUSION ACT A FARCE

ACCORDING TO THE OPINION OF AN OFFICER OF THE TREASURY.

Men in the Confidence of the Government Making Fortunes by the Illegal Importation of Chinese.

New York, October 14.—Colonel J. Thomas Schart, Chinese inspector for the southern district of New York, has sent to the secretary of the treasury his resignation. He says that in his opinion, based on four years of practical experience, and close observation, the Chinese exclusion act is a farce and has resulted in the corruption of the treasury department.
