PISCO CHINAMAN HONORED

San Francisco, Nov. 29.—Lou Look Tin, a native of Trinity county, won all the honors at the triennial exhibition held by the Chinese government at Peking, and is entitled by his standing to hold a representative position under the government. He stood first in a class of 200 and was especially commended by the emperor.

The first business would be to confirm the annexation of Hawaii which would be done by ratifying the treaty or by legislation.

BERGMANN GOING WRONG

San Francisco, Nov. 29.—A. Bergmann, bookkeeper for the California Ink Company, 43 Commercial street, is under arrest for embezzlement. He is said to be short in his accounts several thousand dollars, but the exact amount is not given out by his employers. Bergmann, who is about 51 years of age, came from Portland, Or., where he was employed in the tax-collector's office.

NOTED FRENCH SOLDIER DEAD

Paris, Nov. 29.—General Foreman de Hostoumard is dead. He was in his 77th year. When the Franco-Prussian war broke out he was appointed general of brigade. In 1879 he was promoted to the rank of general of division. In 1881 he commanded a division of the Tunisian expeditionary corps which occupied Jaffa. He was then appointed chief commandant of the corps of occupation in Tunis, where he remained until 1883. He had the decoration of the Legion of Honor and received the grand cross May 4, 1885.
