Judge Bellinger Cives a Decision in the Whiskey Hougarling Cane.

Portland, Or., Dec. 1.-In the United States district court today Judge Heilinger decided the case of the United States against fifty cases of whiskey seized by the customs officers on the wharf here and held for forfeiture for attempted importation into Alaska. He sustained the exceptions to the likel and made an order directing the United States. marshal to turn over the liquor to the claimant, William Siner.

The whiskey was seized just before the departure of the steamer Elder for Alaska about a month ago packed in cases marked "Cumberland Home-Made Cat-, sup." This is the first case of the kind to come before the courts.

Judge Bellinger said: "The fact that Offy cases of distilled spirits were tabeled "Cumberland Home-Made Catsup" has no bearing on the question of an attempt to Import it into Alaska. This false designation is evidence of an intention to violate the presidential regulations against the importation of spirits into Alueka; but the intent is not the act, nor an attempt."






