New York, Dec. 2.—A dispatch to the World from Paris says:

Rydliff Sanderson was received into the Catholic church two days before she married Antonio Terry, the immensely rich Cuban. The wedding was very quiet. The mayor officiated and in a felicitous address offered his good wishes to the beautiful nuptials. After the wedding breakfast Mr. and Mrs. Terry started for Italy, intending to make the journey by easy stages.

### BAKED HIS LEG

Berkeley, Cal., Dec. 2.—E. H. Himm, a sophomore in the university, has a leg baked in an oven at a temperature of 300 degrees Fahrenheit to cure a sprain. This is 88 degrees higher than the temperature of boiling water and twice the heat at which meat is ordinarily roasted for the table. The sprain disappeared with wonderful rapidity. The injured limb was treated in a specially prepared apparatus consisting of a copper cylinder resting on iron supports with a gas burner underneath. Himm's leg was wrapped in absorbent cotton, and placed in the cylinder with non-conducting rubber tubes closing the interior so that the hot air could not escape. After three bakings the sprain was entirely cured.

### BOUWER KILLED.

Delle Plaine, Ia., Dec. 2.—A. R. Sibley, a merchant in Sheffield, Ia., was shot dead while robbing a neighboring store. The safe in his private apartments had been opened. In the safe were many diamonds, gold bracelets and jewelry of every description, including 12 gold watches. His goods had been stolen by Sibley, who was identified by Sibley's neighbors.
