Populism has received a knockout blow by two recent decisions of the Washington state supreme court.

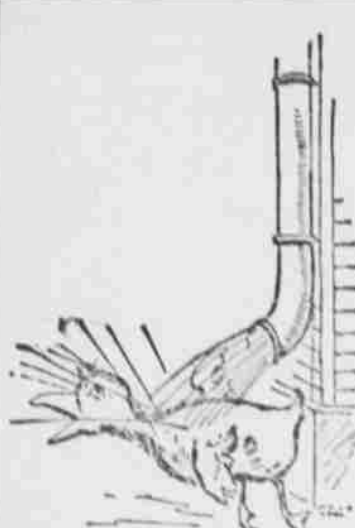
