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WYOMING BATTALION

San Francisco, May 24.—The latest arrivals at the military camp at the Bay District track are comfortably quartered, although Utah and Wyoming are somewhat short of tents. Wyoming has the promise of the government that its soldiers will be sent to the front as soon as it is possible to fill up a regiment, but will go into service as an independent battalion. It has an assurance also that it and the Utah batteries will be sent away together about the first of June.

Many of the officers have city flags and many of the men have taken to Montana if allowed to do so. Colorado is distinguished by its beautiful flag. It has the only garnet flag in the camp, and its hospital flags are unusually beautiful. Colorado is unique in having a yellow fever man who knows all about the disease and a cook who is not prepared to match any of their men against sharpshooters in any other regiment.

PHILIPPINE FOURTH ORGANIZED

San Francisco, May 24.—An order has been issued by the Philippine War Department, transferring all the troops now here with the exception of the Third Artillery, Fourth Cavalry and the First Washington Volunteers, to General Otis' command, the preliminary step in the thorough organization of General Otis' command in the Philippines.

MANGROVE CAPTURED

Chicago, May 24.—A special to the Chronicle from Key West says: It is rumored here that the light-house tender Mangrove has been captured by the Spaniards. The little vessel is said to have been picked up by a Spanish gunboat off the coast of southern Cuba, where it was supposed she was grasping for the Bahama cable to cut off communication from Havana. The Mangrove was especially equipped for the service. All attempts to obtain confirmation of the capture have been without success.
