ANNEXATION AND THE CONSTITUTION.

The old style statesmen who regarded everything progressive—all that enlarged consolidated or illuminated the country as unconstitutional—are still in evidence thumping the old whangoodle harp-strings. A southern senator who has many points to commend him, is at it day by day. He thinks it is awfully unconstitutional to annex Hawaii. He gapes sorrowfully into the future if in any case the United States is made larger or the nation becomes more national. It's a curious streak in the politics of the United States that so many able southern men have devoted themselves to spinning fine phrases about the limitations of the constitution—seeking to wrap up this country in a document. The constitution of the United States is the most respectable of documents; it has been repeatedly amended, and perhaps as often nullified, but it has answered the purposes of the people. The States have not lost anything by the aggregation of power in the general government, except the right of rebellion, the assumption that one of the forty members in partnership can destroy the symmetrical structure of the whole and respect the right of all—crack the wall and doom the edifice to destruction. The nonsense that has been wasted upon alleged strict construction of the constitution would be ridiculous if it had not caused a sea of bloodshed. Once it was thought the peculiarity of making much more of the restrictions than find a place in the constitution than the vital forces that animate the whole great paper and have educated the people in orderly liberty, was due to the institution of slavery. The pro-slavery men who would have extended slavery, picked out certain words in the war and wove of the fundamental law, and exploited them as barriers that must stand forever against public opinion—the multiplication of the people, the expansion of interests, the consolidation of communities—every form of gain. These gentlemen regarded as certain interpretations of words by no means obvious, as firm as the rock of ages "twisting the billows of the skies," not only protecting the peculiar relation of slavery against all assaults for all time, but providing for its extension—that it might hold the balance of power in the senate and stand equal with the larger growth of freedom. At last it was asserted that by virtue of the constitution slavery was carried into the territories, and could only be excluded by state sovereignty. It was upon this wonderful issue that the Southern Confederacy was organized and the war fought. The abolitionists were equally strict constructionists in their way; they had pet phrases, picked here and there out of the constitution. It was said of the war in this country, beginning in these conflicts of construction, radical and unapproachable on both sides, that the war legislated. Mr. Grover Cleveland condensed a huge matter in two words. He said "War legislated." It did so, and also interpreted the constitution, with the greater efficacy than the war powers amended it. The trouble over the constitution, of course, was chiefly about slavery, but the human mind is fertile in the production of issues. Now we have a great deal said about "our traditional policy," which is supposed to be against the annexation of islands. There would be nothing more unconstitutional in annexing Cuba than there was in purchasing Louisiana or Florida, or the conquest of Northern Mexico—another way of naming California. But there is terror in the eyes of some of our great men upon the subject of annexing anything any more. The world has just grown ripe for policies of annexation by all the great powers, and we are one of them. All the clamor that can be raised about the annexation of Hawaii as unconstitutional is simply the sound of hammering words that certain gentlemen conceive have a hidden meaning for them. Thomas Jefferson had sense enough not to be a crank about the constitution when Napoleon was ready to sell his title to a body of land that is

still more than half the area of the United States. Jefferson knew it would be an intolerable blunder for him to make a scarecrow out of the constitution to hoodoo the nation and cut down its proportions. He was a far-seeing man, and knew of his own foreknowledge that the policy of making a fetter of the constitution upon the limbs of the United States could not be permanent. Those who profess to be Jefferson's followers should take heed of his example.

The only hope the opponents of the annexation of Hawaii have of defeating that measure is in blocking the way with barrels of sugar. The sleek and ambitious arguments, the crooked and cunning citations of pretended precedents, will not be influential. The fight against Hawaii has become a feeble case of filibustering. It would be a nice idea to send the news around the world while General Merritt is on the way to be military governor of the Philippines, that the United States had become such a chaos of stupidity that the gift of the Paradise of the Pacific by the people there is authority to our authority had not been accepted. There was never anything quite as absurd as that in the affairs of a dignified and powerful nation. We shall have Hawaii, of course, if not in one way in another, and there is nothing in the special pleas of lawyers or the particular quirks of other public men that will prevent our people from having their own way. In entering upon a colonial policy—in asserting the imperial prerogative of the American republic in putting this nation "in the saddle," as Bismarck said Prussia was to be put and was put—there is a necessity to come to some determinations that require serious consideration and an executive and representative policy definite and determined. One thing is, there must be no haste in the admission of more States. There is a state sovereignty that is constitutional, legitimate, essential and commanding. STRANGE SPOTS ON THE SUN.

Since the beginning of this year groups of spots unusual and unexpected have been observed on the surface of the sun by astronomers in different sections.
