Treasury Department Allows Vessels to Enter and Depart. SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 1.-T. H. Goodman, of the Southern Pacific company, is in receipt of a ruling by the treasury department on the question of whether or not foreign vessels will be allowed a clearance for any port or ports in Hawaii and to enter and to land their cargoes at such ports, now that the islands are American territory.

The coinage for the month of August amounted to \$1,219,898, breaking all previous records in the United States.
