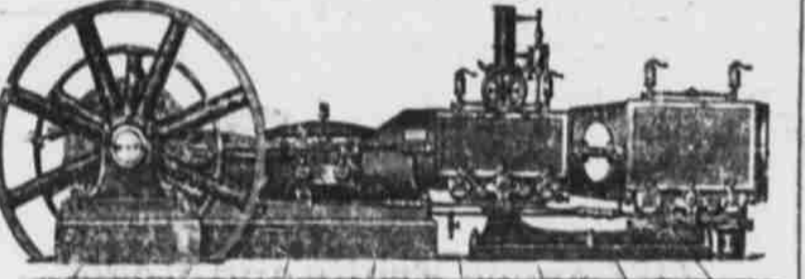

KITCHNER THE LION OF LONDON

Returned General Highly Honored in the English Capital.

EXPOSURES OF MR. HOOLEY

Defunct Capitalist Still Telling Tales About English Millionaires—No Hope for Mrs. Maybrick.

(Copyrighted 1898 by Associated Press.) LONDON, Nov. 5.—Apart from politics, the attention of London this week has been mainly directed to the ceremonies in honor of General Kitchener yesterday and to the resumption of the exposures of Mr. Ernest Terah Hooley, the bankrupt company promoter.

Mr. Hooley's statements during last Wednesday's bankruptcy examination brought forth a crop of disclaimers from titled and other gentlemen, whose participation in his profits, according to Mr. Hooley's evidence, was in no wise credible.

The temperance party won a moral victory this week in attacking the sale of intoxicants within the house of parliament, which is in the anomalous position of breaking the laws made by its members.

The great South Wales collier strike was no sooner over than another is now threatened owing to the miners in defense of their agreement with the employers, deciding by a big majority to retain every Monday as a holiday.

The London county council this week decided by an overwhelming majority in favor of the compulsory purchase of all the London water companies, involving many millions of pounds sterling.

Baroness Bouquet has arrived here from France and has paid her semi-annual visit to the authorities. She was permitted to visit her daughter, Mrs. Maybrick, who is undergoing imprisonment for life, after having been convicted of poisoning her husband, at Alsbury prison, Wednesday.

Claude Vautin, a metallurgist and inventor known on the Pacific Coast where he has lectured on mining subjects has left London, after a financial coup by which he secured 20,000 pounds (\$100,000) in bank of England notes and American Railway securities.

The wedding of the Earl of Stafford to Mrs. Colgate will probably occur in America.

Republicans and Fusionists Both Claim to Be in the Lead—Montana Will Likely Go Democratic.

SEATTLE, Nov. 5.—Compared with two years ago, there has been little in the campaign which will close next Monday night. A considerable falling off in the vote is indicated: The claims of campain committees are widely divergent.

FRIGHTFUL DEATH OF A BOOTBLACK

Terrific Abuse and Dragged to Death Along a Lonely Portland Highway.

MURDERERS ARE UNKNOWN

The Victim Was Angelo Sericko, a Boy of Fifteen Years—Believed Several Are Implicated in Murder.

PORTLAND, Nov. 5.—Within the city limits of Portland one of the most heinous crimes imaginable was discovered about noon today. The victim was Angelo Sericko, an Italian boot-black, 15 years old, upon whom first an aimless assault was committed and who was then dragged to his death by his assailants.

Young Sericko's body was scratched and bruised from being dragged and, with the marks of a rope still around his neck, was found in an orchard on East Burnside street, between Twentieth and Twenty-first streets. The boy had not returned home last night and his family, which lives within 200 feet of the place where his body was found, had been alarmed by his absence.
