AN EVASIVE ANSWER.

Elsewhere we copy an Oregonian editorial in reply to the Astorian's claim that the heavy ship tonnage possible at Astoria and impossible at Portland would add millions, annually, to the products of this basin if the O. R. & N. Co. would make Astoria a common point with Tacoma.

The editorial concedes (vaguely, it is true) our claim that Astoria's heavy ship tonnage would add three millions to our producers' pockets. It makes the concession as follows: "The economies of commerce, the Astorian declares, rest largely upon increase in the size and depth of ships. This is a fact both true and familiar."

It is not only an absurd answer, but it is a false one. Philadelphia has now a 30-foot channel as against Portland's 24-foot channel. Yet practically all the wheat goes past that city to New York for foreign shipment, in spite of a heavy railway differential to Philadelphia. Why is that so? Simply because the wheat is worth more to the producers at the coast port than at a far inland port of however great depth.

Further, it would be impossible for the "Port of Portland" to build and maintain a 30-foot channel for 100 miles. Its construction would cost \$100,000,000. It would bankrupt Portland. Even the United States could not accomplish such a gigantic feat in face of the annual spring freshets of the wild and turbulent Columbia. Why then such a wild scheme of uncertain results, in face of almost certain failure, when giving the A. & C. equal rates with the Northern and Baltimore, with a loss of vast millions annually to the producers, how long would the people of that section stand such oppression? Verily, in the language of the apostle, they would wipe the earth with that pool and scatter it to the uttermost quarters of the globe.

"Talk in newspapers or elsewhere," says in a letter to Dr. Pierce, "never made a port and never will make one." But if an unthoughtful press of this basin shall arouse our people to the inquiry of the O. R. & N. Co.'s refusal to make an "open railway" to the sea by means of common point rates with Tacoma, the desired result will follow like magic. It would not simply "increase land values in Astoria," as the small organ of the wheat pool (the East Oregonian) says. Nor is it true, as that S. O. says, that "the news, papers of the Island Empire have no interest in Astoria, other than what it creates for itself by worthy efforts."

This fleet port on earth is worth vast and increasing millions to the Island Empire and to all honorable newspapers of that great region. It is the key to immense wealth for all those people and of Portland also, as the Astorian's exhaustive pamphlet shows. The S. O. neglects to answer that fair and complete argument except by mere assertion. Such assertion as that if "there were such a difference between charters between the two ports it would not be a week before Astoria would be shipping wheat to Liverpool." It ignores the fact set out in that pamphlet, and well established, of the incomplete condition of our road and of the hostility of the O.

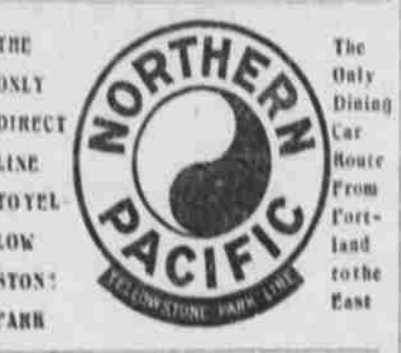
