



THE TROUBLE IS FAR FROM ENDED. American Officers Think the Uprising in the Philippines Will Continue. NEED OF REINFORCEMENTS. Not Enough Troops There to Make the Conquest Complete - Volunteers Want to Return Home.

MANILA, April 7, via Hong Kong, April 10.—Though hundreds of Filipinos are daily returning to their homes and are desirous of resuming peaceful pursuits, and though the proclamation issued by the United States Philippine commission has given an impulse to this movement, the war is far from ended. One of the foremost American generals said recently: "We will see 100,000 soldiers in the Philippines before the Americans control the islands," and a majority of the army officers are of his opinion.

NEW YORK, April 9.—A dispatch to the Herald from Washington says: Inspector General Brockbridge, who has just returned from inspection trip in Cuba and Porto Rico, in an interview says: "Since the United States has been in possession of Cuba, the condition of the island has naturally immeasurably improved. I have no idea that there is any danger of insurrection against the United States. The minds of the people at this moment are of a conviction of the payment of the \$20,000,000 to the Cuban insurgents."

TAOACOMA, April 10.—Oriental advices state that a sensation has been caused at Peking by an edict issued by the emperor, however accurate it was at last week's end, the monthly settlement bill, and I am assured that the adjustment of accounts was attended by no small anxiety in several directions.
