MANUFACTURERS WINNING NEW MARKETS.

While our soldiers are risking the flag over the conquered islands of the Pacific American mechanical skill and enterprise are conquering new markets across the seas on a scale without precedent in the commercial history of the country. The remarkable record of exports of manufactured goods in the fiscal year of 1898 will be distanced in 1899 by many millions of dollars.

The reports of the treasury bureau of statistics show that during the eight months ending February 28, 1899, the exports of manufactures were not only \$25,000,000 in excess of the imports of manufactures, but more than \$25,000,000 in excess of the imports of the corresponding months of the fiscal year 1898. In the 304 business days covered by the report the American manufacturers exported \$26,000,000 worth of manufactures, or more than \$1,000,000 per day.

A notable feature of our exports of manufactures is the heavy demand for American bicycles in all parts of the world. The exports of bicycles to Argentina increased from \$10,000 to \$117,432 in the corresponding months of the year 1898. In the same period the exports of bicycles to British East India increased from \$10,000 to \$116,425.

Equally notable is the increase in the value of American locomotives shipped to foreign countries. During the eight months ending with February 28 last, the exports of locomotives were valued at \$1,138,000, an increase of \$65,000 in value over the shipments for the corresponding months in 1897-8. To secure this trade the American manufacturers had to meet the competition of English manufacturers. They not only met it, but captured contracts for supplying English and Welsh railways with locomotives.

This remarkable invasion of markets heretofore supplied by the English, French and Germans is due to the superiority of American workmanship and the adoption of many improved methods of manufacture unknown to foreign competitors. The United States is destined not only to feed the world, but to supply it with the instruments of industry and commerce.

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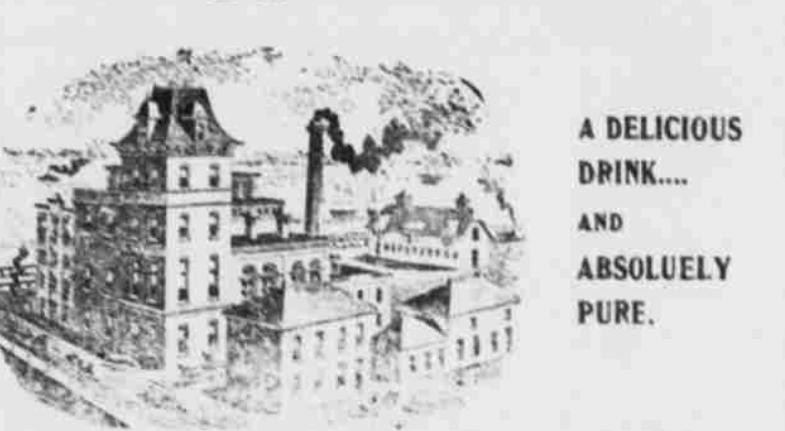
