O. R. & N. FREIGHT RATES.

The East Oregonian says: It is plain to be seen that much more of the wheat of the Inland Empire will go down the Columbia river route to the sea in future than in the past, to the advantage of Portland and the encouragement of the opening of the Snake and Columbia to free navigation, from Lewiston to Astoria.

To intensify this adverse range condition the home and foreign demand became heavier. There was not the stuff to meet it, so the market crept up to the packer, who needed cattle, and, hence, the wholesale price of beef advanced.

To meet the home demand and to fill regular export refrigerated beef orders, which required about 1,000 cattle weekly, the export of live stock fell from 236,631 head for the seven months ending July, 1898, to 196,320 head for the same period, ending with the close of last month.

Cattle cost the slaughterer, it is asserted, from one to one and a half cents per pound more this year than last, and this makes carcass beef cost one and a half to two cents a pound more.
